

RIVERSIDE PARK ICE RINK SCHEDULE

Skating rink hours, weather permitting, are as follows. No one is permitted on rink during non-scheduled time slots.

Schedule allows for 15 minutes between sessions for resurfacing

Thursdays – 5:00 – 8:00 – Hockey free play

Fridays – 6:00 – 9:00 – Free skate

Saturdays – 9:00 – 11:45 – Free Skate

Saturdays – Noon – 2:45 – Family Skate

Saturdays – 3:00 – 5:45 – Free Skate

Saturdays- 6:00 – 9:00 – Free Skate 12 and over

Sundays – 9:00 – 11:45 – Hockey free play

Sundays – Noon – 2:45 – Family Skate

Sundays – 3:00 – 5:45 – 12 and over

When groups are waiting, playing time is limited to 1 hour per group.

Holidays (Winter Break, Martin Luther King, and President's Day) will follow the Sunday schedule, except for New Year's Eve when the rink will close at 3:00)

**ABSOLUTELY NO ONE IS ALLOWED ON THE ICE

WARNING: *This facility is to be **used at your own risk**. Ice skating is a hazardous recreational activity which can result in serious injury, broken bones, brain damage, paralysis or even death. The Borough of Oakmont does not assume any responsibility for damage or injuries resulting from the use of this facility.*

- *Skating is only permitted during designated times and when "Rink is Open" sign is posted*
- *All skaters must sign in before they are allowed on the ice*
- *No food, beverages or glass allowed on the ice at anytime*
- *Skaters under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an on-site guardian.*
- *Skating in a manner that endangers or interferes with other skaters' safety or pleasure is forbidden – this includes roughness, excessive speeding or weaving through other skaters, tag or any other games*
- *Additional obstacles or other materials (ramps/jumps) are not allowed.*
- *No more than two people may skate together*
- *Only skaters allowed on the ice - no one is permitted on the ice without skates*
- *While on the ice, skaters must keep moving*
- *Skaters are not allowed to carry children or secondary items while skating*
- *All exits are to be kept clear at all times*
- *Incidents or malicious destruction are to be reported to the monitor immediately*
- *No one is allowed on the ice during resurfacing*
- *Throwing snowballs or any objects is strictly prohibited*
- *The Borough is not responsible for any personal items stolen or left within or around the premises*
- *Helmets and gloves are recommended.*
- *Depending on conditions, surface may be rutted.*
- *Ice rink is to be used on a first-come, first-served basis. Do not use the rink if it is too crowded for you to skate safely. Skaters must take turns and respect other skaters.*
- *Do not use the ice rink if the ice is melted. Damage to the liner will occur.*
- *All Riverside Park rules apply*
- *Report any illegal activity, including vandalism and graffiti, to the Police. In case of emergency, call 911*
